



## SAMPLE ITINERARY: ARGENTINA

### SUMMARY:

Take a 3-credit university Humanities course at a local accredited university while enjoying a blend of European and South American cultures and taking in stunning natural beauty, cosmopolitan cities, and delicious cuisine.

- **Trip Length:** 15 Days / 13 Nights
- **Begins In:** Buenos Aires
- **Ends In:** Buenos Aires
- **Highlights:** Buenos Aires, Mar del Plata, Los Cardales, 5 Exhibition Games, 3-credit Humanities Course

### DAILY SCHEDULE:

#### Days 1-2:

**Travel:** Arrive Buenos Aires

English Speaking Guided Group Transfer to Hotel

**Cities:** Buenos Aires

**Highlights:** Arrival in Buenos Aires, River Plate soccer match

**Meals:** Lunch, Dinner

- Depart on your overnight flight from the US to Argentina.
- **Welcome to Argentina!** Upon arrival in Buenos Aires, know as the “Paris of the South”, meet your guide and driver for your group transfer to your hotel for a **welcome meal, orientation, short walking tour, and attendance to River Plate soccer match.**

#### Day 3:

- Morning class at university within walking distance of hotel.

- Then on to elegant **Palermo** to visit the **National Library, Law School, Museum of Latin American Art of Buenos Aires, and 3 de Febrero Park.**

**Highlights:** Plaza de Mayo, 9 de Julio Avenue, La Boca, San Telmo, Puerto Madero

**Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- Morning class at university within walking distance of hotel.
- Private city tour of Southern and Historical Sights. Tour includes starts at **Plaza de Mayo** to see the **Government House (Pink House)**, and the **Cabildo**, Buenos Aires' first city hall, and the **Congress Palace**.
- Then down the world's widest street, **9 de Julio Avenue** to see the **Plaza de la Republica** and **Colon Theater**.
- Next is the colorful neighborhood of **La Boca** which is home to the one of the world's most famous soccer stadiums, **La Bombonera**.
- Head over to one of Buenos Aires' oldest and most preserved neighborhoods, **San Telmo**.
- Finish in modern **Puerto Madero** with its converted warehouses that overlook **Rio de la Plata**.
- Private **Dinner and Tango show at La Ventana** with guide. See up close the passion and intricacy of Tango while enjoying a steak dinner at La Ventana in the heart of San Telmo.

#### Day 6:

**Cities:** Buenos Aires with English Speaking Guide

**Highlights:** Exhibition Game

**Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- Morning class at university within walking distance of hotel.
- Evening **Exhibition Game** against local collegiate or professional team.

#### Day 7:

**Travel:** Private Motorcoach from Buenos Aires to Mar del Plata.

**Cities:** Buenos Aires & Mar del Plata with English Speaking Guide

**Highlights:** Arrival in Mar del Plata

**Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- Afternoon departure by motorcoach from Buenos Aires to Mar del Plata, Argentina's top resort beach town.

**Highlights:** Mar del Plata City Tour

**Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- City Tour of Mar del Plata. See the traditional and residential districts with old French-style wooden houses.
- Then off to **Lourdes' Cave** and the port to see the sea lions.
- Drive up the gorgeous coast on the way back to the city for a final stop at the city center to see the **Cathedral, Plaza San Martin** and **Town Hall**.
- Evening **Exhibition Game** against local collegiate or professional team.

**Cities:** Mar del Plata & Buenos Aires with English Speaking Guide

**Highlights:** Laguna and Sierra de los Padres

**Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- Excursion to **Laguna** and **Sierra de los Padres**. Go to the pioneer settlement of Laguna to see the **Jesuit Mission of Our Lady of Pilar** and the **Jose Hernandez Museum**.
- Continue through the hilly countryside and ranches to **Sierra de los Padres** to enjoy the panoramic view of the area.
- Evening departure by motorcoach from Mar del Plata to Buenos Aires.

#### Day 10:

**Cities:** Buenos Aires with English Speaking Guide

**Highlights:** La Bombonera

**Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- Morning class at university within walking distance of hotel.
- Visit to **La Bombonera** for tour of Boca Juniors soccer club facilities

#### Day 11:

**Cities:** Buenos Aires with English Speaking Guide

**Highlights:** Exhibition Game

**Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- Morning class at university within walking distance of hotel.
- Evening **Exhibition Game** against local collegiate or professional team.

#### Day 12:

**Highlights:** Fiesta Gaucha at Estancia Santa Susana

**Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- Morning class at university within walking distance of hotel.
- Private **Fiesta Gaucha**. Visit **Estancia Santa Susana**, a ranch outside of the city in the town of Los Cardales for a **traditional steak lunch** and inside look into the gaucho (cowboy) culture of Argentina. You will explore the ranch while gauchos prepare a steak lunch, eat, and then watch a typical music and dance show and gauchos display their horsemanship skills.

**Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- Morning class at university within walking distance of hotel.
- Evening **Exhibition Game** against local collegiate or professional team.
